Long time ago, horses did not look the same as the big animals we see today. The first horse was only 0.4 meter tall! It had four toes on each foot.

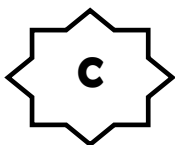


As time passed, horses changed. Slowly, a horse's toes grew into a hoof. Horses also grew

bigger and ran faster. Today, there are three main types of

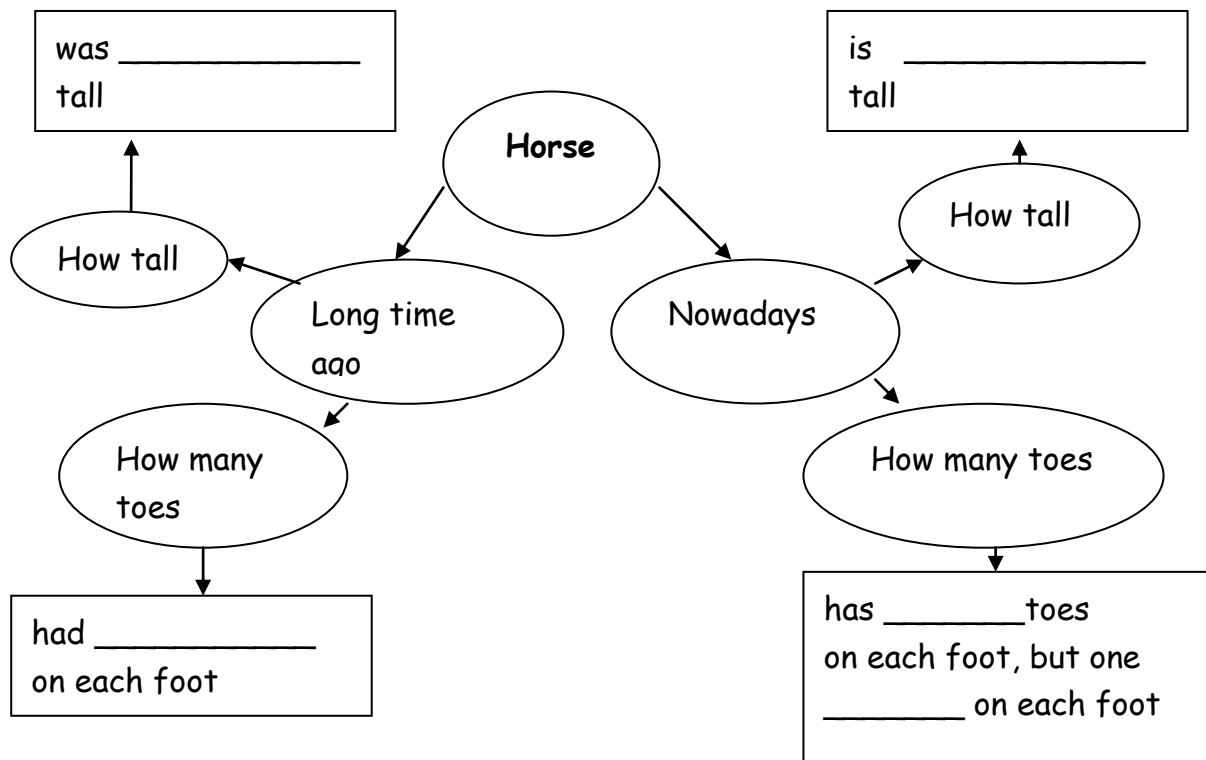
horses. They are for leisure activities, sports , and

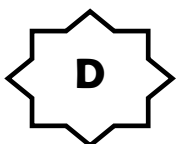
